In order to give each and every veteran expedited attention and care, we encourage that you arrive on a scheduled day.

Thursday, March 30, 2017, those who have the last two digits of their Social Security number ending in 00-33

Friday, March 31, 2017, those who have the last two digits of their Social Security number ending in 34 -66

Saturday, April 1, 2017, those who have the last two digits of their Social Security number ending in 67-99

- We have made arrangements for parking in other areas should the parking facilities be full. Bus transportation is being prepared to take you to and from Post 10.
- Those who have handicap difficulties should proceed to the portico of Post 10 where you may enter. Our transportation provider will then be able to instruct you where to park.
