## Fall Conference

Room rates are \$71 plus tax and reservations may be made by calling 1-800-445-8667. **Cut off date for reservations at this rate is October 7, 2005.** Be sure to tell them you are with The American Legion. There will be quite a few awards chosen during the Committee meetings. Be sure your Post and its dedicated Legionnaires are represented and possibly awarded by submitting nominations for the many awards available. See an outline of the awards in the following articles.

## Post Commander and Post Adjutant of the Year

Please be sure to nominate your Post Commander and Adjutant for this important award! The award, approved at the 1997 Fall Conference, should be based on the activities and work of the preceding American Legion fiscal year. This year's nomination should be someone who held office from June 2004 – June 2005. The nomination forms are enclosed with this mailing. Please submit any completed forms to Department Headquarters by **October 15, 2005.** The Community Service Committee will judge both awards and present the winners at the Fall Conference.

## Post Newsletter of the Year

The Public Relations Committee will select the Post Newsletter of the Year Award winner at the Fall Conference. Any Post that wants to submit their newsletter in the competition needs to provide a copy of each newsletter mailed out in the last year. Send your newsletters to Department Headquarters **no later than October 15, 2005.**

## Law Enforcement Officer of the Year

The Law and Order Committee will be selecting the North Carolina Law Enforcement Officer of the Year at the **Fall Conference.** Please read over the guidelines for this most important award included in this month's mailing. The winner will be North Carolina's submission to National Headquarters in January. Please follow the guidelines closely as this will help with the format National requires. Let's recognize our Law Officers by nominating them for this award.

## Boy Scout High Adventure Awards

Each year at the Fall Conference the Boy Scout Committee selects one scout from each Division to award up to an \$800 scholarship to attend a recognized National Boy Scout High Adventure trek or a National or international Jamboree. Included in this mailing is a sheet enumerating the eligibility requirements of scouts and a nomination form. All applications must be received at Department Headquarters by **October 15, 2005.**

## Baseball Hall of Fame

All nominations for inductees into the Baseball Hall of Fame should be sent to Department Headquarters by **October 15, 2005.** The Baseball Hall of Fame Committee will make the selection at the Fall Conference. Please use nomination form enclosed.

## Colon Furr Selection

The Colon Furr Scholarship Committee will be selecting recipients at the Fall Conference. Enclosed with this mailing is the application complete with the changes and the deadline of **September 25, 2005**. Each post may only submit ONE applicant. If you have two worthy applicants, try to get another post in your area involved. Please get these applications distributed ASAP so as many nursing students as possible will be able to compete for this scholarship.

## **Employer Awards Program**

Each year the American Legion National Economic Commission and The Department Veterans Employment and Veterans Preference Committee honor Employer of The Year in 5 categories. Those are:

1. The Employer of Veterans Award (Small= 50 or fewer employees)
2. The Employer of Veterans award (Medium=51-200 employees)
3. The Employer of Veterans Award (Large=201 or more employees)
4. The Employer of Older Workers Award
5. The Employer of Disabled Award

Nomination forms for these programs have been distributed to each North Carolina Employment Security Commission Office in North Carolina. If your Post knows of any employer who should be honored in one of the categories, please contact your local ESC office and work with them in filling out a nomination form. If you need a copy of any of the forms, please call Department Headquarters. All nominations are to be forwarded to Department Headquarters no later than **October 15, 2005 or turned in on Friday morning October 21 in Raleigh** for judging at the Department Fall Conference. The Department winner in each category will be forwarded to National to compete for the National Award.

## **Undeliverable PUFL Addresses**

Until the PUFL members are contacted, the following procedure is being implemented by National Headquarters. No member credit will be affected, and no payment will

They will also provide a list and a letter of explanation for each post affected. A current phone number is also needed for these members. Bottom Line: "Update Your Records!"
