8. VSF/USSNC donation. Just get it done.
9. Promote the Programs of the American Legion with a membership team. It's not a One Person Job.
10. Social Media, Newspaper, Word of Mouth. Let everyone know what you are doing.
11. Programs & Family. Make your Post a place for the whole family with youth programs & family friendly events.
