## Fall Conference

The Fall Conference will be held October 17-19, 2019 at the North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, NC. Room rates are \$101 plus tax per night. For reservations call 1-800-445-8667, identifying yourself as being with The American Legion **by September 18 for the rate**. This conference is always a busy one. There will be quite a few awards chosen during the various Committee meetings. Be sure your Post and its dedicated Legionnaires are represented and possibly awarded by submitting nominations for all those deserving recognition.

## Hotel Reservations

Why should you stay at the North Raleigh Hilton for our conferences and conventions? We have a contract with the North Raleigh Hilton through the Fall Conference in October, 2020. With this contract we estimate the number of rooms that we will need for our attendees. With these rooms we are allowed all of the meeting rooms free of charge and this includes all of the meeting rooms for The American Legion, SAL, and Auxiliary. If we do not meet our minimum guest room usage, then we have to pay for all of the meeting rooms that we use. This would drastically affect your Department budget and consequently affects you as a member. The two conferences and one convention that we have each year is and should be very important to all of our members to carry out the business and programs of The America Legion, SAL and Auxiliary. The bottom line is, you staying at our assigned hotel is very important and necessary for all of us to continue the business of your Department, your Division, your District and your Post. ### Post Excellence Award

The Post Excellence Award Program honors posts that show excellence in membership participation, youth activities, community service, and support to veterans and US Troops. District Commanders must certify posts as having fulfilled the four specified criteria. Each qualifying post receives a certificate of recognition, mailed to the Department and awarded to the post. Get busy and get involved & good luck.

### MyLegion.org

This is a great tool for you and your post to use especially with your membership program. It is imperative for your post Adjutant to fill out and send the **Post/Squadron Commander & Adjutant Notification Form** to this Department, with your up to date name and contact information for your Post Commander and Adjutant. If this form is not submitted, National will not give you a password to use Mylegion.org.

**This form is very important!** If you need a copy of this form, please contact Department Headquarters.

### Update Post Information

Please fill out the Department Post Information form that was mailed previously dealing with your post commander and adjutant, and monthly mailing information. This must be done each year to insure that we all have the latest contact and location information for your post. This is important for many reasons. Legion officers, including the Department Commander may need to get in touch with you. Someone may move into your community and want to join your post. A veteran or active duty military personnel may need help and assistance. If you need a form, contact Dept Headquarters or go to the [nclegion.org](http://nclegion.org) website. We appreciate your cooperation.

### Post Newsletter Award

As in the past, the Post Newsletter of the Year awards will be selected at the Fall Conference in Raleigh October 17-19, 2019. Each Post submitting its newsletter for judging should provide a copy of every newsletter mailed to the membership in the 2018-19 Legion year, starting with the first newsletter after the installation of officers.

A cover page containing the Post name, number and address, name of editor and the name and address of the person submitting the contest entry must be included. To increase the chance of your entry arriving intact in Raleigh, you might consider using some sort of binder or cover and who knows, a neat looking entry might just catch the judge's eye! Lastly, be certain your entry is received at Department Headquarters before October 10, 2019. If you choose, you may hand deliver your entry to the PR Committee at the conference. Meeting time and date will be confirmed in subsequent mailings.
