Note: A "Shut-in Veteran" to ONS is a veteran that is dependent on others; confined to his/her living quarters. And, he/she doesn't drive and can't leave the home without the assistance of others.

Peer Fishin' Festival on Ocean Crest Pier at Oak Island: October 18 - 22

It's back. One of Operation North State's most popular family outings. We're BEYOND EXCITED to welcome the event back. Operation North State, our partners, volunteers, supporters and venue- partner Ocean Crest Pier have begun the planning activities for the outing. We are bringing back our popular "Peer Fishin' Festival" to Ocean Crest Pier at Oak Island!!! We have been through a few tough years related to hurricanes, rebuilding communities and then COVID but, the Peer Fishin' Festival is back. And, it's not just for a day - BUT for the week of Monday, October 18 - Friday, October 22.

Needs: Bottom-rigs, volunteers to serve as pier—mates for a day and financial assistance to assist in purchasing lunches, snacks and bait. The pier fishing passes, t-shirts and daily lunches and snacks will be made available to all participants.

<u>Hosting Cycling Heals – Vets Connect Outings</u>: Monthly

Hosted the second Tuesday of every month at Salem Lake in Winston-Salem. It's an incredible venue. All Veterans – especially wounded warriors / DVets and the general public are welcomed.

Need: Come out and support this great cause; we have around 40 attendees each month. And, we always need cash donations to assist in purchasing snacks and beverages. Our expenses are very low for this outing but every cash donation helps. AND, we always need used-bike donations which we rework and provide to wounded warriors / DVets requesting bikes back in their respective communities.

<u>Host Boaters offering One-on-One Fishing Trips throughout the state to wounded warriors / DVets</u>: Daily

Need: Host Boaters to host wounded warriors / DVets throughout the state to ALL TYPES of fishing – including private pond / lake fishing too. And, we always are in need of rod & reel combos and fishing tackle / equipment donations which we match up with our wounded warriors / DVets in need.

North Carolina's avid golfers, country clubs and premier golf courses host NC's wounded warriors / DVets to quality rounds of golf followed by lunch (quality golf, fellowship and making new friends).
